SALE AND REMOVAL OF CONFISCATED VESSEL

I. GENERAL

Pease Development Authority (PDA) Division of Ports and Harbors is accepting bids for the sale and removal of a vessel confiscated by the Division of Ports and Harbors (DPH) pursuant to NH RSA 12-G:52-b. The vessel is a 1978, 41 foot, Chris Craft with fiberglass construction, and twin gasoline powered engines, with HIN CCH08173M78J. The vessel is being sold “as-is.” The minimum bid is \$3000. The vessel is located at the Hampton Harbor Marine Facility, 1 Ocean Blvd. Hampton, NH, and may be viewed there during normal business hours. Payment in full and transfer of ownership must be completed within ten (10) days of acceptance of a bid and notification of award. The vessel must be removed from the Hampton Harbor Marine Facility by the successful bidder, during normal business hours, no later than thirty (30) days after the transfer of ownership has been completed. Failure to satisfy these deadlines may result in a revocation of the acceptance of the successful bid and an award to the next highest qualified bidder at the sole discretion of the Pease Development Authority.

II. BID SUBMITTAL

The attached bid form is required for this bid and must be delivered to the following address **not later than 11:00 AM local time on Monday, May 10, 2021**, at which time they will be opened publicly and read aloud.
