

PUBLIC MEETING

The **Pease Development Authority Transportation Committee** will meet on **Wednesday, July 12 at 8:30 AM** at the offices of the Pease Development Authority, **55 International Drive, Portsmouth, NH 03801** to hold a public presentation of the proposed project to construct road improvements to the intersection of New Hampshire Avenue, Pease Boulevard, and Arboretum Drive in the Town of Newington at the Pease International Tradeport.

The project seeks to improve air quality and reduce traffic congestion at the intersection of the referenced streets by constructing a right turn lane on New Hampshire Avenue. The project is funded through the federal Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality program (CMAQ Project #42879) and is administered by NHDOT. The federal grant funding covers 80% of costs with the Pease Development Authority providing a matching 20%.

The purpose of the public meeting is to present the identified design alternatives, the pros and cons of each, and provide an explanation of how the proposed action best meets the project's purpose and need and makes sense for this location. The public will have an opportunity to comment on the proposed action.
