Bids for the construction of **Reconstruct, Light and Mark Taxiway 'A' North** at the Portsmouth International Airport at Pease will ONLY be received and accepted via online electronic bid service through QuestCDN, [www.questcdn.com](http://www.questcdn.com) until 2:00 PM, April 24, 2024 and at such time will be opened publicly online. Alternatively, the public may view the internet opening at the office of Pease Development Authority, 55 International Drive, Portsmouth, NH.

The Project consists of a base bid that includes the reconstruction of Taxiway 'A' North from the runway holding position to Taxiway 'D', and the rehabilitation of taxiway shoulder pavement beyond the runway holding position to Runway 16. The purpose of the project is to reconstruct Taxiway 'A' North per new fillet geometry and widen the shoulder pavement from 25' to 30'. The project will include but not limited to; removal and installation of new asphalt pavement and subbase materials, relocation of existing taxiway lights, removal and installation of new duct banks and electrical cables, removal and installation of new drainage and underdrain pipe, installation of new catch basins and underdrain cleanouts, adjusting existing structures to grade, installation of new markings. The project is entirely within the secure area of the airport.

Bidder shall submit a bid via online electronic bid service through QuestCDN, [www.questcdn.com](http://www.questcdn.com) (see "Instructions to Bidders"). An optional pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 AM, Thursday, April 11, 2024 at Pease Development Authority, 55 International Drive, Portsmouth, NH 03801. This will be the only time for prospective Bidders or subcontractors to view the site, therefore, all interested bidders are encouraged to attend in order to prepare acceptable bid submissions.

Prospective bidders are asked to provide information on whether their company is listed as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) in the state where the work will be performed in order to comply with FAA regulations. Prospective bidders will be asked to provide this information at time of plan purchase.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in the bidding or to reject any or all bids.

Each bidder must deposit with their bid, security in the amount of 5% of the bid in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the General Provisions.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract. The Contractor on this work will be required to comply with the equal employment opportunity requirements of the Federal Aviation Administration and the Portsmouth International Airport at Pease DBE Program. PDA, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252, USC §§ 2000d to 2000d-4), hereby notifies all offerors that it will affirmatively ensure no businesses will be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin (including limited English proficiency), creed, sex (including sexual orientation and gender identity), age, or disability in consideration for an award.
